

Seek God for Revival - Prayer Points - November 27, 2024

“Suddenly, there was a sound from heaven like the roaring of a mighty windstorm, and it filled the house where they were sitting. 3 Then, what looked like flames or tongues of fire appeared and settled on each of them. 4 And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability.” (Acts 2:2-4) Pray that this mighty move of the Holy Spirit from heaven will come in all fullness upon the church.

Revival is God’s answer when the message of salvation is not getting through to multitudes of people. Christians who recognize that changes are desperately needed, come together to pray for the church to grow in Jesus, to be revived spiritually. They plead with God as in Isaiah 64:1 “Oh, that you would burst from the heavens and come down! How the mountains would quake in your presence!”

During revivals Christians begin to hunger and thirst for more of God like the early disciples experienced. Jesus encourages us in Mark 9:23 “If you can believe, all things *are* possible to him who believes.” And in John 14:12 Jesus said, “Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater *works* than these he will do, because I go to My Father.” Pray for a special move of the power of the Holy Spirit among believers.

God has planted eternity in the human heart (Ecclesiastes 3:11). This seems to be saying that every person alive has some concept of a supreme God in eternity. Jesus tells His disciples in John 4:35, “Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest!”

The great desire of the Father. He has called us to be His people, His church, blood bought, redeemed by Him. Matthew 28:19-20 “Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations ... I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age.” Our call is to occupy until Jesus comes. We want to always be ready for the return of Christ, and yet continue to follow God’s plan for us to go forward.

Jesus by His blood paid an incredible price on the cross. Hebrews 10:19 says, “Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus.” The blood of Jesus gives us access to God, the Father. Like Jesus, we can make intercession for the brethren, the backsliders and for the lost. Who we are in Christ is all through His blood. We are forever eternally grateful!

God says, “For I am about to do something new. See, I have already begun! Do you not see it? I will make a pathway through the wilderness. I will create rivers in the dry wasteland.” (Isaiah 43:19) Pray for the minds of the lost to see the pathway to new life in Christ in this dark world.

So, keep praying every day to seek God for revival.
