

Seek God for Revival - Prayer Points - October 16, 2024

God is love: 1Corinthians 13:2 says, “If I had the gift of prophecy, and if I understood all of God’s secret plans and possessed all knowledge, and if I had such faith that I could move mountains, but didn’t love others, I would be nothing.” As we seek God for revival, pray that we will recognize how important it is for us to be an expression of God’s love working through us.

Seeking God for revival will only work when we understand Christ’s love. God’s love never changes (Malachi 3:6). It is an everlasting or eternal love, (Jeremiah 31:3). 1John 3:16 says, “We know what real love is because Jesus gave up his life for us. So, we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters.” Pray that by this love that the world will know that God sent Jesus.

All the fullness of God dwells in Jesus (Colossians 1:19). When we discover the width, the length, the depth, and the height of God’s love we are filled with the fullness of God (Ephesians 3:18-19). Our ability to love is due entirely to His prior love for us and in us (1John 4:19). As we seek God for revival, He is pleased when Christ and His love has first place in everything (Colossians 1:18).

When Jesus prays in the Garden of Gethsemane, His burden and His love is so great for all humanity. He is in emotional agony to the point of shedding blood. What an example that is for us to earnestly seek God for a breakthrough to revival. There is so much at stake. Jesus lived His life to win people, and our hearts are impacted to carry on His ministry.

Jesus says, “love your enemies!” Matthew 5:44-45 “Pray for those who persecute you! ⁴⁵In that way, you will be acting as true children of your Father in heaven.” Jesus is trying to teach all His followers to reflect His love. He says: I’m not just here for church folks. I’m here for those who are absolutely against Me. I’m here for those who say they will never believe in Me. I have come for everybody.

The glory of the Holy Spirit that poured out on the early disciples is experienced by us today. The Holy Spirit continues to make our relationship with our Jesus very real in our lives. We have the glory of Jesus with us everywhere. And Romans 5:5 says, “the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit.”

“All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ.” (Ephesians 1:3) “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him. But God has revealed *them* to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.” (1 Corinthians 2:9-10.)
